

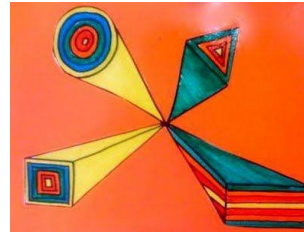

Students will be read a book, <i>When a Line Bends a Shape Begins</i>. After reading the book the teacher will explain that there are two types of shapes; geometric and free form/organic. Students will get to watch a short video, Shape Song and follow the video making shapes in the air with their hands. After we discuss shapes, the teacher will explain the activity. Students will receive a piece of paper and each table will have a bag of shapes. Students will first trace shapes on their paper using a black crayon, making the shapes overlap. When they finish, they will color in each shape using different colors.</p>

Third Grade

I will learn about elements of art and create a piece of artwork using shapes.

3: Students will see a video about the elements of art focused on shape. We will discuss the two different types of shapes, geometric and free form/organic. Students will be making a piece where they can show perspective using shapes. I will model how to draw the geometric shapes using rulers and how to add lines to make it look like the objects are moving from a point of perspective.



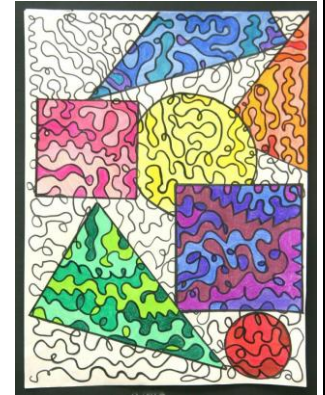

Fourth Grade

I will learn about elements of art and create a piece of artwork using shapes.

4: The students will learn about elements of art focusing on shapes. Students will watch a short video about shape. After watching the video the teacher will explain that there are two types of shapes; geometric and free form/organic. The teacher will explain that we are going to be creating a piece of artwork using geometric shapes and a curvy/loop-de-loop line. After we discuss the difference between the two types of shapes, the teacher will explain the activity. Students will receive a piece of paper and each table will have a bag of shapes. Students will first trace shapes on their paper using a pencil. The teacher will model how to make the loop-de-loop lines and how to color each geometric shape using different shades and tints of the color.



Fifth Grade

I will learn about elements of art and create a piece of artwork using shapes.

5: Students will see a video about the elements of art focused on shape. We will discuss the two different types of shapes, geometric and free form/organic. Students will get to see some of Paul Klee's artwork. They will study the shapes Klee using in his artwork. Students will be creating a piece inspired by Paul Klee. Students will make a drawing of a castle using different geometric shapes. They will use free form shapes in the background for the stars and moon. Students will discuss the difference between using different colors (day and night).
